## **RESIDENT LIFETIME LICENSES**

A special license offered by the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department for residents of New Hampshire. The following lifetime licenses are available: fishing license, hunting license, combination hunting and fishing license, archery, muzzleloader and deer crossbow. These license types are only available at Concord Headquarters or through the mail. This is an opportunity for anyone who expects to continue hunting and/or fishing in the future, because it fixes the cost of a license permanently. The fee for this license is not refundable for any reason. Similar to insurance annuity premiums, the rates are higher at younger ages as shown on the attached fee schedule (effective Jan 1, 2007). The Lifetime Hunting and Combination Hunting & Fishing Licenses include the bear license. Lifetime License holders do not have to pay habitat fees in the ensuing years.

Purchase of a Lifetime License can only be made at the Fish and Game Headquarters or by mail provided the following documentation is presented along with the attached application completed and signed.

- 1) A valid New Hampshire driver license or non-driver photo ID.
- 2) A previously held hunting license or hunter safety certificate and/or a previously held archery license or bow education certificate.
- 3) If you currently hold a Lifetime License, you must return it to the Department upon application for additional lifetime licenses. All lifetime license types will be printed on the same form and you will keep the same license number.

If you are applying for a Lifetime Muzzleloader License or Deer Crossbow License you must hold a Lifetime Hunting or Combination Hunting and Fishing License. If you are applying for a Lifetime Archery License and have not paid your Wildlife Habitat Fee for the year you must include that \$2.50 fee with the license price listed.

If applying by mail, please make the check payable to the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department in **the amount shown on the attached fee table at your presently attained age**. The Department cannot be responsible for original documents, only copies of the documents should be mailed. Your license will be mailed back to you, it must be signed. If you would like your license laminated please return it to the Department. If you have any questions please call the Licensing Department at 271-3422. Allow 5-10 business days for processing.

**RESIDENT LIFETIME LICENSE APPLICATION**

Fis 1101.03(a) Each applicant for a lifetime license under RSA 214.9-c shall submit a copy of their valid NH Driver license or Non Driver photo ID as evidence of their age and residence status and complete the following form:

(To be used in the Firearm deer season)

If you currently hold a Lifetime License, you must return it to the Department upon application for additional lifetime licenses. All lifetime license types will be printed on the same form and you will keep the same license number.

\*If applying for Combination or Hunting License the applicant must remit a previously held hunting license or hunter education certificate issued by any state, any year. If applying for an archery license the applicant must remit a copy of a previously held archery license or bow education card issued by any state, any year.

\*\*Those purchasing a lifetime muzzleloader or deer crossbow license must have a lifetime hunting license.

**Hunter Statement:** I certify that my privilege to take deer, bear, moose or furbearing animals is not under suspension or revocation in any state or province (RSA 214:18-b). and further certify that I am aware that conviction of certain felonies in any state or province prohibits the possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon.

**Resident Affidavit:** I hereby certify that I am a resident of the State of New Hampshire and that I do not claim residence in any other state for any purpose (the word residence as used shall mean domicile).

**Amount shown on the attached fee table at your attained age at the time of issue will be charged.**  
***I understand that in no case shall the license be transferable or any portion of the cost refunded.***
