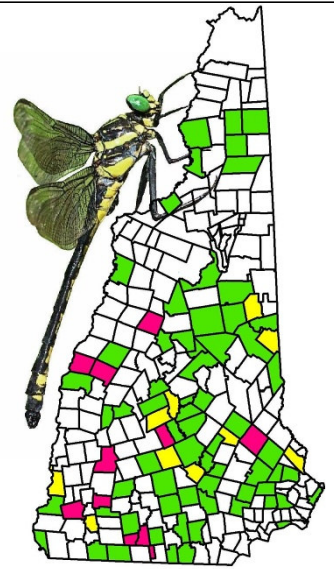


# New Hampshire Dragonfly Survey: 2009 Workshops

Are you interested in dragonflies and damselflies?  
Do you know where to look to find them?  
Would you like to learn how to identify dragonflies and damselflies?



Scientists in New Hampshire are working on a project to increase our understanding of the conservation issues affecting these fascinating insects, and you can help!

The NH Dragonfly Survey started in 2007 as a partnership of NH Audubon, NH Fish and Game, and UNH Cooperative Extension. Its goal is to gain a better understanding of the distribution of dragonfly species of conservation concern in New Hampshire. Volunteers can participate by attending an introductory workshop that will train amateur citizen scientists (that's you!) to collect data at priority habitats and poorly surveyed parts of the state.

The Survey is hosting three official workshops in 2009. Workshop participants will learn basic dragonfly biology, issues in dragonfly conservation, and the project's goals and survey protocols. Weather permitting, the workshop will include afternoon time in the field to learn capture and identification techniques. There will also be opportunities later in the summer to hone your new skills.

The workshop fee (\$30) covers the cost of materials, including a field guide to identifying dragonflies and damselflies (Field Guide to the Dragonflies & Damselflies of Massachusetts, by Nikula et al.). Participants who do not wish to receive the field guide may attend the workshop for a reduced price of \$10.
