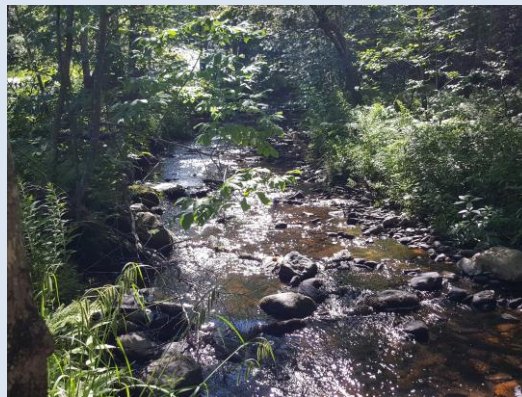




Watershed Ecology Institute (WEI)
